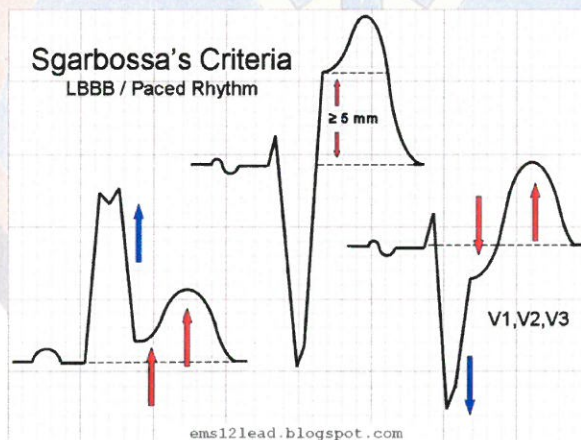

Effective immediately, Christian Hospital EMS and its contracted Emergency Medical Response Agencies will use the following criteria for activating the STEMI/Cardiac Catheterization Lab at any of our TCD-approved STEMI centers:

- Any compliant, sign, or symptom concerning for acute coronary syndrome plus one of the following:
 - 1 mm of ST-segment elevation in two contiguous leads
 - In males, V2 & V3 need 2 mm of ST-segment elevation for STEMI
 - Isolated ST-segment depression in V1-V3 concerning for posterior MI
 - ST-segment elevation in V3R – V4R concerning for right ventricular MI
 - Any Sgarbossa's criteria in Left Bundle Branch Block (LBBB) or Ventricular Pacemaker
